

Patient Confidentiality

Patient confidentiality is a conscious effort that is made to keep private all personal information revealed by the patient while receiving healthcare. This may include (and is not limited to) the patient's identity, physical or psychological condition, emotional status and financial situation. All patient information is confidential and shall not be disclosed without the consent of the patient, the patient's representative, or unless required by law. Confidential patient information shall not be communicated to any person (including healthcare providers) unless that person has a clear need to know (such as other physicians and personnel under the direction of the physician who are participating in the diagnosis, evaluation, or treatment of the patient).
